If you have ever searched “lathe” or “woodturning” on YouTube you have probably watched a Carl Jacobson video. Carl has been uploading wood turning videos to YouTube since way back in 2007 and since then has amassed a collection of 249 videos. That’s a lot of time and effort put into making free woodworking videos for everyone’s enjoyment and education.



Saturday, October 1st, \$25.00 Demo starts at 9:00am

Carl has an extensive program for us. He will turn a three-piece lidded box decorated with either Milliput epoxy inlay or Dremel bit accents. Then he will turn a Yin/Yang platter. Carl will show how to make fantastic objects from recycled automotive paint. He will talk about steel vs. carbide turning tools, tool tips, and his sanding methods. Lunch is on your own.

Sunday, October 2nd, \$95.00 Hands-On starts at 9:00am

Carl will guide the class through making two or three projects: a three-piece lidded box decorated with either Milliput epoxy inlay or Dremel bit accents, turn an object from recycled automotive paint, and an off-center turned goblet. Class size limited to 10 students. Beginners should have a basic knowledge of lathe and tool use, turns currently. See examples in the above photos. Wood and Lunch is furnished.
