

Would you like to make this 3-legged stool?



The KC Woodturners and teacher Anthony Harris has scheduled a Beginning Spindle Turning Class. No lathe experience is necessary. Club membership is not required. The class will supply all tools and wood needed to make a 3-legged stool with three identical legs. You don't need to buy anything. The class will teach basic spindle turning, spindle duplication using a story stick, an introduction to cross-grain turning, four methods of mounting work on a lathe, tool sharpening, blind splines, and mortoise and tenon joints.

The class will consist of 16 total hours of learning on four consecutive Saturday afternoons from 12:30pm to 4:30pm on September 22nd and 29th and October 6th and 13th. The first two days of class will teach the woodturning skills needed to make a good spindle. If you already know your way around a spindle gouge, more advanced goals will be provided. The last two days of class will consist of making the stool using the knowledge you've learned. The stool is approximately 17" tall with an 11" diameter seat.
