Basic Box Making Class

This will be a fun but intensive two-afternoon (8-hour) class. The class is designed for novice and beginning turners – or people who would like to improve their skills at box making.

We will make two boxes of different kinds. One plug-style, and one cap-style. The important topics will be efficient order of operations, end-grain hollowing, making good mortise-and-tenon joints, and there will be some time for investigating shapes and detailing. Tool sharpening, sanding, and finishing will be covered.

This class will be followed by two single-day classes on how to make targeted, more advanced shaped boxes. If you have doubts, this is a good start for the next box classes.

KC Woodturner membership is not required.

The class will be held on two afternoons: 4/15 Saturday and 4/16 Sunday from 12:30pm to 4:30pm in the KC Woodturners club facility, 3189 Mercier St., KCMO. Tuition is \$115 per student. Class is limited to 8 students. All wood and use of a wood lathe will be provided. Best to have your own tools, but some can be provided if you don't have any. No tuition refund after class start.

Tool List: 1/2" spindle gouge 1/2" round-nosed scraper 1/8" parting tool

Optional Tools: roughing gouge skew small hollowing tool side-cutting scraper
