Basic Box-Making Class

This will be a fun but intensive two-afternoon (8-hour) class. The class is designed for novice and beginning turners – or people who would like to improve their skills at box making.

We will make two boxes of different kinds. One plug-style, and one cap-style. (Anyone who finishes both, there will be examples of a third type of box to try.)

The important topics will be efficient order of operations, end-grain hollowing, making good mortise-and-tenon joints, and there will be some time for investigating shapes and detailing. Tool sharpening, sanding, and finishing will be covered.

KC Woodturner membership is not required. The class will be held on two afternoons: 10/24 Saturday and 10/25 Sunday from 12:30pm to 4:30pm in the KC Woodturners lathe room, 1717 Washington St., KCMO. Tuition is \$120 per student. Class is limited to 8 students. All wood and use of a wood lathe will be provided. It is best to have your own tools, but tools can be provided if you don't have any. No tuition refunds after class start.

Tool List: 1/2" spindle gouge, 1/2" round-nosed scraper, 1/8" parting tool.
Optional Tools: roughing gouge, skew, small hollowing tool.
