Scoop Making Class -Jan.18, 2020

Learn how to make turned wooden scoops on the wood lathe during this one-afternoon class. The shape of these scoops is unconventional and eye-catching but are very useful. Take a look at some photos.



The class is designed for turners with basic level skills. The class will supply all tools and wood necessary, but you may bring your own tools if you like. Club membership is NOT required. The topics consist primarily on spindle turning with a spindle gouge and end-grain hollowing. We will work at learning tool control and efficiency in the use of the spindle tools. Optional topics are reverse turning, and turning thin. We will discuss the appropriate order of operations, drying turned objects, and finishes.

The class will take place on Saturday, January 18, 2020, from 12:30pm to 4:30pm. The class will be held in the KC Woodturners lathe room at the clubhouse, 3189 Mercier St., KCMO. Class tuition is \$70.00 per student. No tuition refunds after the class begins.
