

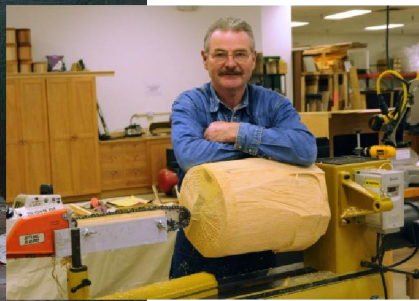
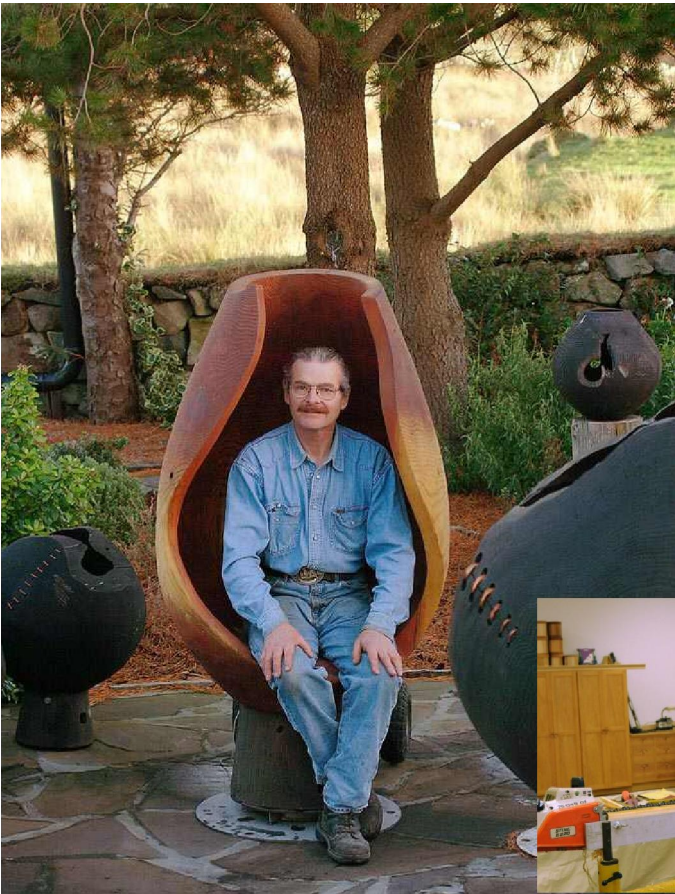
Liam O'Neill

In the morning, Liam O'Neill will show us how to turn one of his signature lidded containers. In the afternoon, Liam will show us his methods of chainsaw turning. His chainsaw turnings can be 7 feet tall and 3 feet diameter. This ought to be exciting! Bring hearing protection if you have it. Lunch is on your own.

Liam will guide the class through making one of his signature lidded containers. Each class member should be able to take home a beautiful work of art. All wood will be provided to the class. Beginners should have a basic knowledge of lathe and tool use, and currently turn. Class size is limited to 10 students, so reserve your place. Lunch is furnished.
