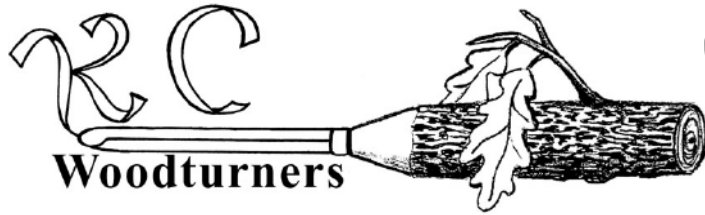

## In Memory

Eldon E. "Mort" Schneider, 80, Shawnee, died Aug. 8, 2005, in Overland Park. Funeral services were Friday, August 12, 2005, at the Merriam Christian Church with burial in Shawnee Mission Memory Gardens. Visitation was Thursday at the Amos Family Chapel of Shawnee. Mr. Schneider was born June 14, 1925, in Topeka. He was self-employed for 43 years as a painting and remodeling contractor.
