

## Lyle Jamieson's coming to KC

The Lyle Jamieson workshop is intended to help turners of all level to improve their skills and techniques. His workshop will begin with information about how to evaluate the wood log in order to saw grain for best use. He will discuss handling of green wood, then teach techniques of using the bowl gouge with modified swept back grind for roughing cuts, push cuts sheer and scraping cuts. He will also share dynamics involved in preventing the dreaded catch. This information will be shared in demonstration and hands-on class through the creation of bowl and hollow pieces.



## Get Out Those Skews

July's demonstration presented by Kent Townsend gave us a general over view of the uses of a skew in woodturning. Kent showed us how a skew is used to make roughing, planing and vee cuts. He also demonstrated making coves and beads on a spindle and creating a pummel. Correctly used the skew is the most versatile woodturning basics tool you will every buy. Skews can obtain a much smoother finish on your blank and do most of the essentials for shaping .



With several sharpening stations set-up, everyone got a chance




