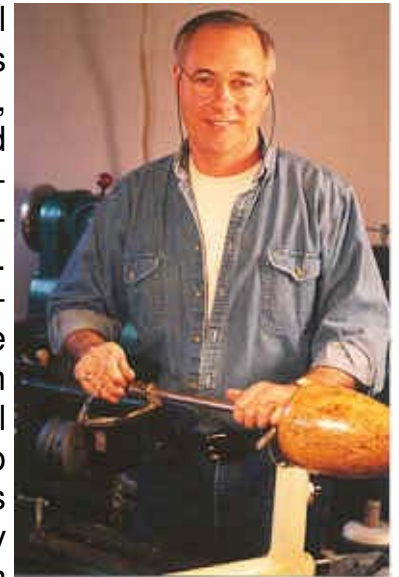

Lyle Jamieson's coming to KC

The Kansas City Woodturners Club presents a great educational opportunity. October 10th – 12th, Lyle Jamieson will be demonstrations and two days of hands-on turning sessions. Jamieson's workshop is intended to help turners of all level to improve their skills and techniques. Saturday's demonstrations start at 8:30, so don't be late. He will discuss handling of green wood, and teach techniques of using the bowl gouge with modified swept back grind. He will also share dynamics involved in preventing the dreaded catch. Saturday's demonstration cost \$25.00 and includes a box lunch. On Sunday participants will use a 5/8 bowl gouge on side grain. The bowl format is to learn effortless control of rough cuts, push cuts, pull cuts, sheer cuts and scraping. Students will learn how to eliminate catches for no fear turning. Sunday's hands-on session cost \$120.00. Monday session will explore the dynamics of hollow form turning. It will include the use of the Jamieson Boring System and laser light measuring devise. Lyle will bring a number of systems for students to use during the class. Monday's class cost \$120.00. Please note the each day will start at 8:30, a half hour earlier than usual because Lyle has a lot of information to share with us. Turners attending either of the hands on sessions must attend Saturday's demonstrations. Anthony Chases a Box

At the August meeting, Anthony demonstrated threading a box. He lead us through the steps of creating the male threads on the box first. Chamfering the edge of the threading area allows the chasing tool to easily enter the wood. The tool enters the wood in a arc so that the first tooth touched first and the others descend behind it. Smooth even motion is need to keep

from creating drunken threads, or uneven thread. Once the thread were struck they are chased to their final depth. Once clean and crisp , the corresponding female thread need to be created. The approximate size of the opening is established and threads are chased in to the top of the box, in this case. Through trial fitting, the crest of the female threads are trimmed off and the threads can be chased deeper to increase the size of the cap until the two pieces can be screwed together. Then the shoulders of the box are adjusted so the grain can be matched. The firmness of the joint then comes from the squariness of the shoulders, not the tightness of the threads. Tightness of the threads could cause an issue later with the seasonal change of the wood. It was a very educational and entertaining demonstration. Thanks Anthony.
