March's Demonstration

Bill Coomer demonstrated the steps of turning an earring stand. Bill had learned the techniques from the late Keith Rowley. The stand includes a drilled earring carrier, base and a center pillar. The project included both spindle and faceplate work. Bill had a jig for pre-drilling the carrier for the top of the stand. He also had a special faceplate made for turning the carrier and the base. It used a friction fit over a wooden pin on the faceplate. When turning the carrier Bill explained the importance of distance between the rim of the carrier and the drilled holes, that it be small enough so that earrings could be put through the holes and hang freely. The spindle was turned as one piece and then parted in two to complete the center post. The pieces are then ready to be finished and assembled. An interesting and informative demonstration Bill.
