Challenges

The challenge for this month was to turn a decorative piece that can be worn. Novembers challenge is to turn a holiday decoration.

September's Demo

Practice is an important aspect of making any piece. For the September demonstration, Ed Bergstedt took us through his process of setting-up to turn a project.

Using a similar sized piece of wood as what will be used to create the final piece, Ed will practice making a piece to get a feel for making the final turning. The practice will help you with selecting the right tool rest, one that is longer than the piece, but does not interfere with the tailstock or chuck. Setting the tool rest at the correct height for the tools you are going to use.

Ed was reproducing a spindle for a head board. From the original he could get the correct measurements and proportions to create the layout for the copy.
